**NB:**

- 1) If you wish to study Mathematics, please indicate above which of the courses on offer you would prefer. All of the Mathematics courses include Pure Mathematics as well as your chosen applied area of Mathematics i.e. Statistics or Mechanics. We do not mix applied modules.
- 2) Double Maths counts as **two** options, so you should write it in twice. It cannot be taken in combination with Mechanics or Statistics.
- 3) *There is no option of taking up A2 Mathematics if you sat the AS examination early. All Mathematics students will be placed in an AS group.*
- 4) English Language/Literature and English Literature is a forbidden combination.
- 5) Students will study 4 subjects from the list above as well as Critical Thinking in Year 12.
